<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Cleaning</b>                      Schools will be supported to implement enhanced cleaning, including cleaning throughout the day of high-touch surfaces such as bathrooms and door handles.                 </li> <li> <b>Physical distancing</b>                      The school workforce will be supported to practice physical distancing, but physical distancing is not necessary between students in the school setting.                 </li> <li> <b>Hygiene</b>                      Frequent hand washing will be encouraged among staff and students and, where soap and water are not available, alcohol-based hand sanitiser will be used.                 </li> <li> <b>Health</b>                      Anyone who feels unwell should not attend school, including staff, parents and students.                 </li> </ul>	<p><b>PREP H, PREP Y, 1 /2 H, 1 /2 Y AND 1 /2 V</b>                      Students in Prep to Grade 2 will return to on-site schooling first.                      ALL STUDENTS NEED A DRINK BOTTLE – NO TAPS                      PLAYGROUND IS SAFE FOR USE.</p> <p><b>Grade 3 – Year 6 students</b>                      Students in Grade 3 to Year 6 continue to learn remotely.                      Students who are unable to learn from home can continue to attend the supervised program at their school.</p> <p><b>Parents</b>                      No parents will be able to be on site or stay around school gates - see below for Pick up and Drop off .                      Confirm with your child where you will park every day.</p> <p><b>Students Walking</b>                      Croydon Rd – enter at gazebo gate                      Kent Ave- enter at Year level gate</p>	<p><b>All students return to on-site schooling</b>                      Students in all year levels will return to school.                      Activities such as camps, excursions and incursions will not be offered until current travel restrictions are lifted.                      Schools will no longer offer a remote learning program.</p> <p><b>Parents</b>                      Parents should follow advice from their school regarding drop-off and pick-up protocols.</p> <p><b>NEW drop off and pick up plans will be provided after a review of the previous weeks</b></p>	<p>Regular school activities, such as sports, camps and excursions will resume consistent with the lifting of travel restrictions.</p>
