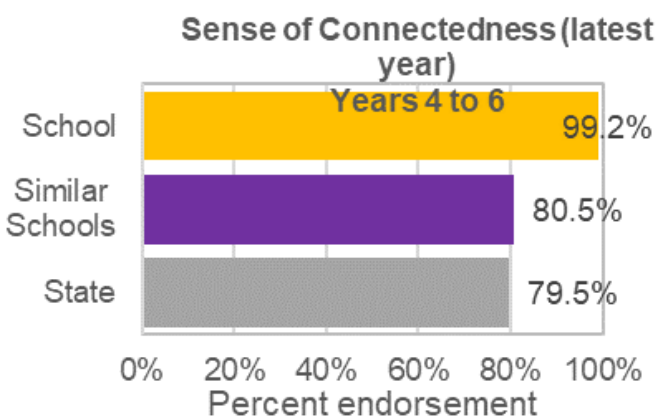
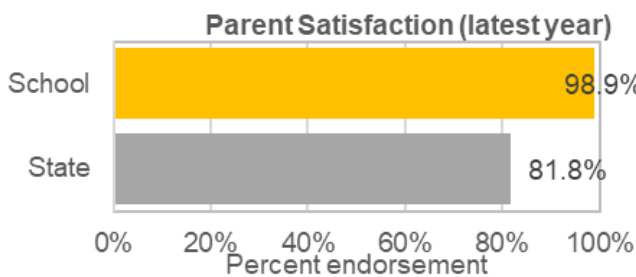

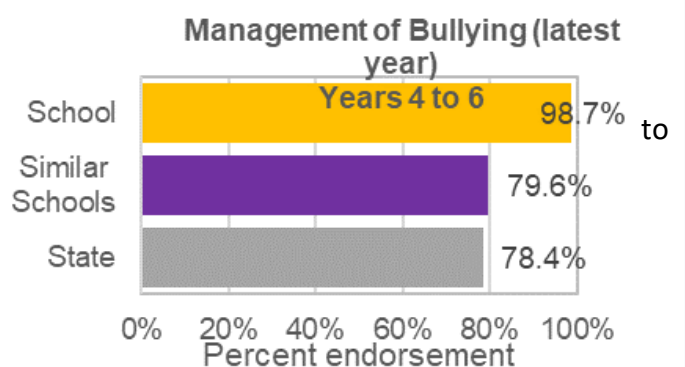
SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT

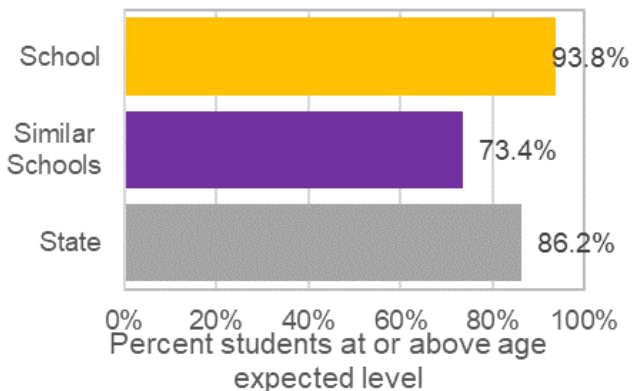

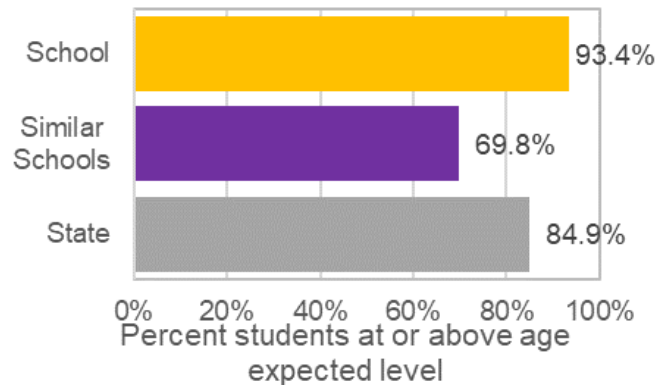

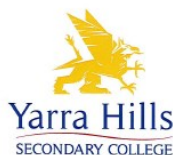
